

REEDLEY CEMETERY DISTRICT
ADOPT-A-TREE POLICY 2013-1

The Adopt-A-Tree Program was implemented by the Reedley Cemetery District Board of Trustees so that families could have a living memorial for their loved ones and for families that may not be able to afford a memorial bench.

2013-1.1: **NO tree may be altered in anyway, i.e., Pruning , planting of any type of plants in the tree well. No digging to place plants in pots or flower vases is permitted in the tree well. No nailing or stapling objects to the tree.**

2013-1.2: No Objects that are offensive or defamatory will be permitted. The Management reserves the right to remove any object that is placed there.

2013-1.3: No objects may be hung from the tree limbs. This is to insure the safety of the Cemetery employees and the public visiting the Cemetery grounds.

2013-1.4: Nothing may be placed in the tree well, including soil, carpet, mulch, rocks, pebbles, bark or any type of statues. No objects may be placed outside of the tree well. ,
NO MYLAR BALLOONS, NO FOOD, NO GLASS, NO METAL OBJECTS.

2013-1.5: Nothing may be placed within the tree well that will damage or affect the health or growth of the tree. NO solar lights or any objects placed in or on the ground. NO framing of the tree well.

2013-1.6: **Cemetery Management reserves the right to remove any objects that are placed within the tree well, and they will be disposed of.**

2013-1.7: Only 1(One) Cemetery supplied memorial marker is allowed per tree. NO EXCEPTIONS. There shall be no alterations to the supplied marker. Such as Painting, drawing, Moving the Marker or writing with any type of marker. The Reedley Cemetery District is no longer participating in the Adopt-A-Tree program.

2013-1.8: The Adopt-A-Tree can not be used to put decorations, fences, solar lights, flags, rocks, carpet or additional dirt or sand etc. **District Manager has the right to remove decorations if they are placed there.**

2013-1.9: Adopt-A-Trees must be kept in an orderly fashion and must be kept looking neat and clean. District Manager has the right to remove any items that are being placed there.

2013-1.10: All Adopt-A-Trees are only allowed to have the one Memorial Marker that was provided . No other decorations are allowed.
